12:00 p.m.	Religious Celebration (Mass)	
	The Quinceañera is walked down the aisle	
	accompanied by her parents and padrinos, and	
	presented for the Mass.	
1:30 p.m.	Religious Celebration Flowers	
•	The Quinceañera will leave her natural flower	
	bouquet at the church as an offering.	
2:30 p.m.	Pictures	
	Adding props like sunglasses or doing fun poses is	
	always fun, don't forget your "Must Have Shots"!	
1:00 p.m.	The Introduction of the Court of Honor	
l:30 p.m.	Quinceañera Reception	
	The court of honor is presented first, prior to the	
	Quinceañera.	
4:35 p.m.	The Presentation of the Quinceañera	
	A Quinceañera may choose to walk in on the arm of	
	her Chambelan de Honor.	
1:45 p.m.	Toast #1	
p	Make a separate list of who will speak during the	
	toast; Include parents, grandparents, padrinos, and	
	friends.	
:00 p.m.	Dinner Time	
:00 p.m.	Toast #2/Memory Video

':00 p.m.	Crowning of the Quinceañera	
7.00 p.m.	The Quinceañera is traditionally crowned by her	
	mother or madrina. The Quinceañera's scepter can	
	also be presented at this time.	
7:15 p.m.	Changing of the Shoes	
7.15 p.m.	The Quinceanera will change from flats into heels as	
	a symbol of her growing up.	
':30 p.m.	Presentation of the Last Doll/Father Daughter Dance	
8:00 p.m.		
	The Quinceañera will give away her doll, and dance	
	with her father.	
	The Quinceañera Waltz/ Surprise Dance	
	The highlight of the quinceañera is the dance your	-
	guests can't wait to see this part!	
8:30 p.m.	Quinceañera Toast	
	The Quinceañera should thank her parents and padrinos	
	during this toast.	
8:45 p.m.	Cake	
	Have some extra tias on hand to help pass out the cake to	
	guests.
